PAIRING A BLUETOOTH DEVICE

1. Turn on the unit using the **Power** switch. Press and hold the **Pair** button once. The **Pairing Indicator** will flash blue quickly, and the unit will enter pairing mode. *When pairing, remain within 3 feet of the unit.*
2. Using the native controls on your Bluetooth device, scan for and select **ISB14** in your Bluetooth settings to pair. If your device requests a password, the default password is **0000**. *Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices.*
3. When successfully paired and connected, the **Pairing Indicator** will display a solid blue light and a beep will sound from the unit.
4. If problems arise with pairing, press and hold the **Pair** button to begin the pairing process again.

PLAYING AUDIO WIRELESSLY

1. To adjust the volume, select, play, pause or skip a track, use the controls on the connected Bluetooth device.
2. Audio played through the connected Bluetooth device will now be heard through the speakers.

USING THE 3.5MM AUDIO INPUT

1. Plug one end of a 3.5 mm audio input cable (not included) into the **3.5 mm Audio Input** on the unit, and the other end of the cable into the audio output on an MP3 Player or other audio source.
2. Audio played through the connected device will now be heard through the speakers. Adjust the volume, select, play, pause or skip a track using controls on the connected media device.

WARNINGS AND PRECAUTIONS

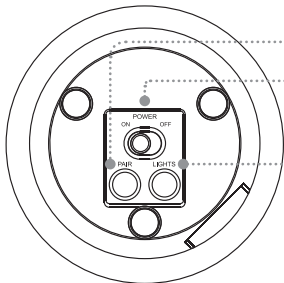

Press and hold to pair to a Bluetooth device.

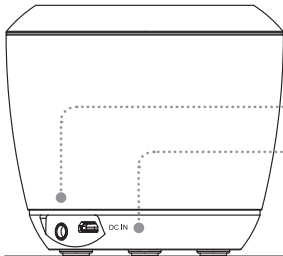
Power Switch
