Important Safety Instructions

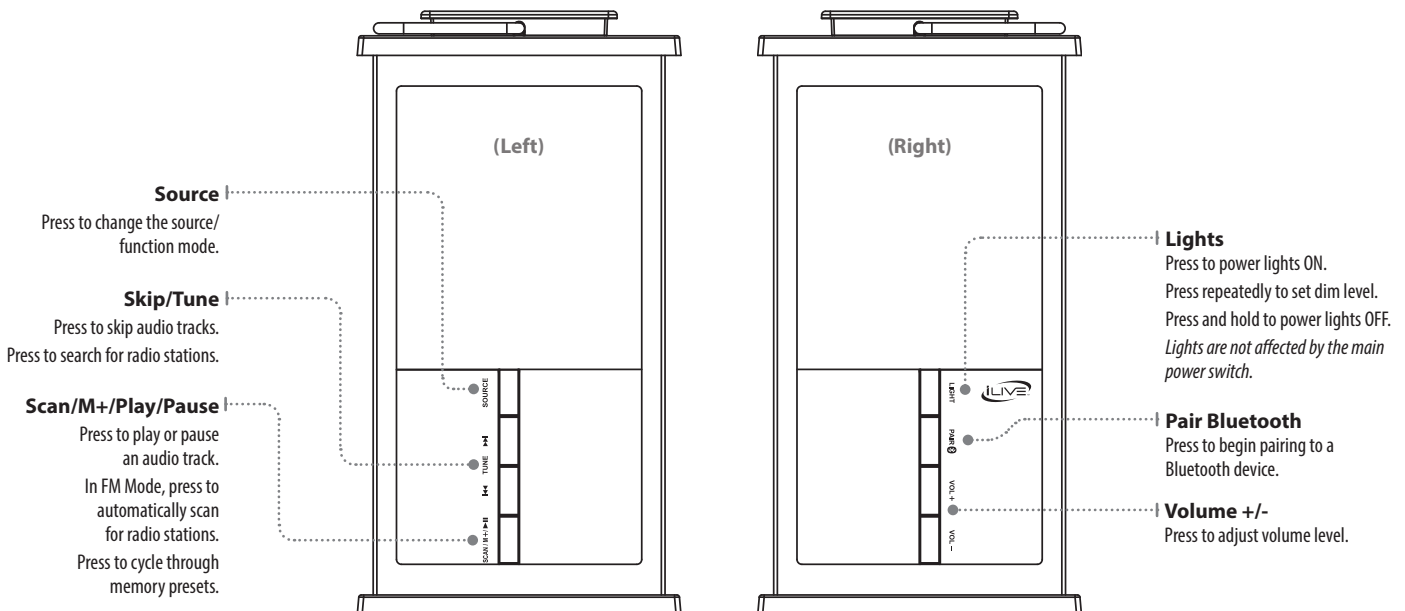
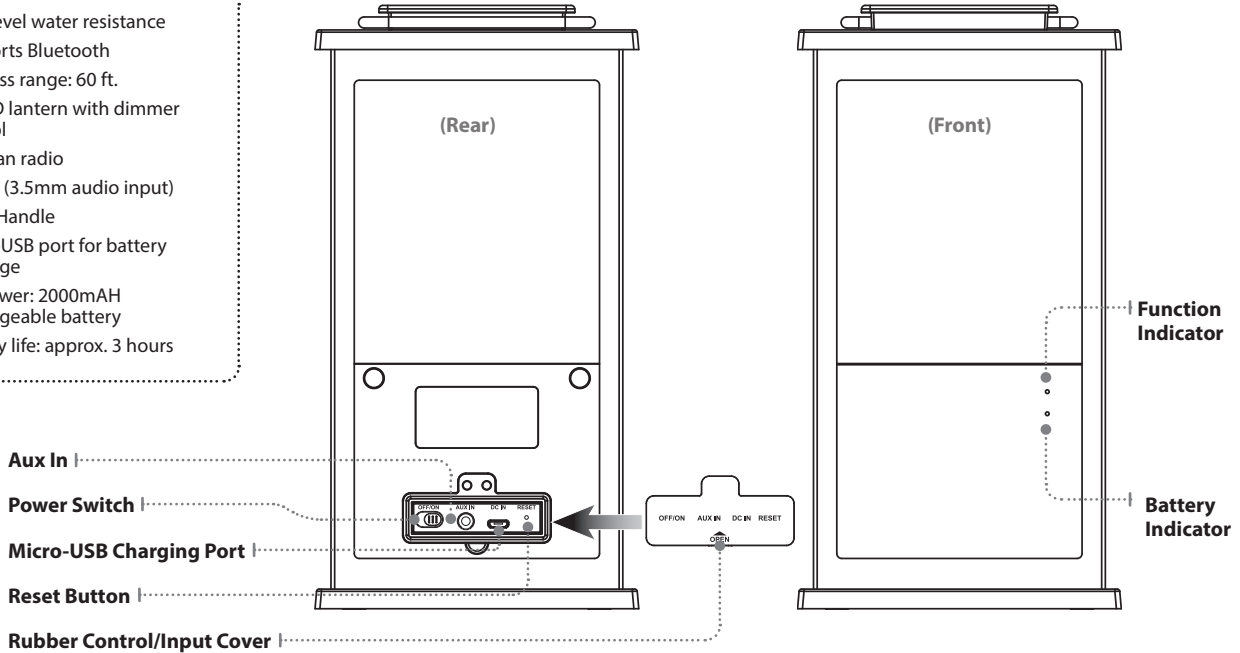

Water Resistance

This unit has a water resistance rating of IPX4. This rating is suitable for indoor and outdoor use in the presence of incidental or light exposure to splashing water, rain, or snow. Water splashing against the enclosure from any angle should have no harmful effects. It is not recommended to submerge this speaker in water for any amount of time.

IMPORTANT: To ensure your speaker is prepared for use in a wet environment, disconnect and remove any power cables, and tightly close the water cap on the rear of the unit. If the water cap is not properly closed, water resistance will be compromised and could result in damage to the speaker or personal injury.

Charging the Battery

Requires a Micro-USB to USB cable (included).

1. Using a Micro-USB to USB cable (included), connect the larger **USB plug** to the **USB port** of a powered on computer or USB power adaptor (not included).
2. Connect the smaller **Micro-USB plug** into the **Micro-USB port** on the back of the unit. The unit will now charge.

Bluetooth Wireless Audio

Pairing to a Device & Playing Audio

After initial pairing, the unit will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the user or erased due to a reset of the device. If your device should become unpaired or you find it is unable to connect, repeat the steps listed here.

1. Power on the unit by sliding the **POWER Switch** to the **ON** position, then press the **Source button** to set the unit to Bluetooth mode. The **pairing indicator** will slowly flash blue.
2. Press the **Pair button** to begin pairing. The **pairing indicator** will quickly flash with a dark blue light. When pairing, remain within 3 feet of the unit.
3. Using the controls on your Bluetooth device, scan for and select **ISBW326** in your Bluetooth settings to pair. If your device requests a password, enter the default password **0000**. Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices.
4. When successfully paired, the **pairing indicator** will turn solid dark blue and an audible chime will sound from the speaker.
5. Use the controls on the connected device to select and begin playing audio. Audio played through the connected Bluetooth device will now be heard through the speaker.
6. Use the controls on the unit or the connected device to play, pause, and adjust volume.

FM Radio

An FM antenna is built into the unit. Adjust the position of the unit to improve radio reception.

1. Power the unit ON, then press the **Source button** to switch to FM mode.
2. Press the **Tune** buttons to manually tune to a radio station.

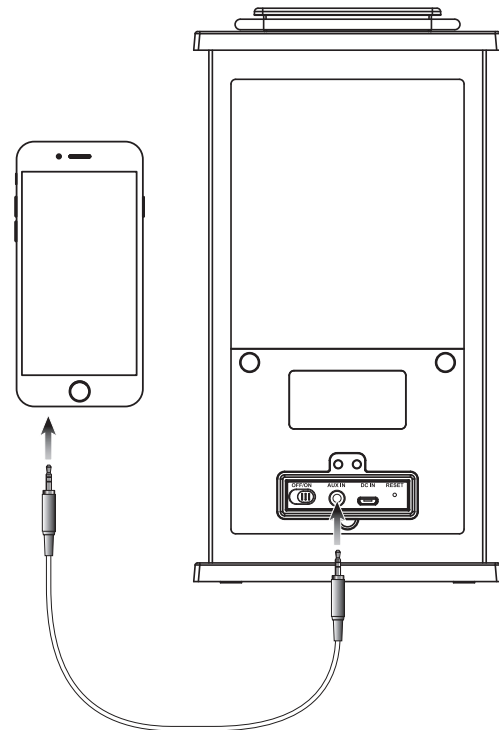
Programming Radio Stations

1. With the unit in **FM mode**, press and hold the **Scan/M+ button** to automatically search for stations. Stations will automatically be stored as they are scanned.
2. Press the **M+ button** to cycle through the memory presets.

Aux In

Requires a 3.5mm audio cable (not included).

1. Connect a 3.5mm audio cable to the **Aux In** on the rear of unit and the **audio output/headphone jack** on a media player or smartphone.
2. Power on the unit by sliding the **POWER Switch** to the **ON** position. The **Pairing Indicator** will light **green**.
3. Use the controls on the connected device to select and play audio.
