Simple to add to your boat

Mounting: Standard bracket or RAM-style options for consoles and T-tops.

Power: 12V with an inline fuse per the install guide.

Cameras: Position for forward visibility, docking, and deck action; adjust to prioritize safety coverage.







Tips from the field

- Angle the primary camera to capture bow traffic and docking lanes.
- Keep a labeled, waterproof case with spare SD cards; rotate weekly.
- Use offline map downloads for areas with spotty service.
- After each trip, trim a 15–30 second "client highlight" and file an incident clip if needed.



FAQs

Does it work without cell service?

CarPlay/Android Auto runs from your phone; many nav apps support offline maps. Cloud features (calls, texts, streaming) require coverage.

How long will it record?

Recording time depends on your SD card size and settings. The loop feature overwrites the oldest footage, so recent hours are always available.

Can I export clips easily?

Yes. Remove the SD card to transfer to a computer or follow your preferred workflow to move clips to your phone for sharing and archiving.

The Captain keeps your phone safe, your helm organized, and your day documented—so you can run the boat, serve clients, and let the technology work quietly in the background.
