Using the wedge base as a guide, mark and drill the 4 holes in the desired mounting location. Please note where the cable is routed when deciding. It is recommended that the low end of the wedge faces forward.








Using nylon washers, or item 5 in the BOM, bolt the wedge base down using nyloc nuts (or similar). Due to varying mounting surface types and thicknesses, ensure the correct mounting bolts and hardware are used.


Route antenna cable through provided cable seal (BOM item







When installing the Starlink Flat HP, line up the antenna with the wedge mounting holes. With antenna resting on the wedge, ensure washers (BOM items 4 & 5) are in place before securing antenna. Use Starlink provided hardware to secure antenna to wedge base. If hardware is not provided, please use 1/4"-20 bolts of appropriate length.






