

MIRROR BRACKET INSTALLATION

- BEFORE PERMANENTLY INSTALLING THE MIRROR BRACKET(1), PLACE THE ASSEMBLY 1. ONTO THE RAILING OF THE PONTOON IN A DESIRABLE POSITION AS SHOWN.
- BE SURE THAT THE MIRROR BRACKET WILL PIVOT DOWN IN EITHER THE FORWARD OR BACKWARD POSITIONS (DEPENDING ON PONTOON BOAT) WITHOUT CONTACTING THE CONSOL OR THE BIMINI SUPPORT BRACKETS. 2
- ONCE THE DESIRED POSITION IS IDENTIFIED, REMOVE THE MIRROR BRACKET ASSEMBLY 3. FROM THE PONTOON BOAT.
- TO PERMANENTLY LOCK THE MIRROR MOUNT IN PLACE APPLY A SMALL BEAD OF THE 4. THREAD LOCKER(3) TO THE THREADS OF BOTH THE 1/2" SET SCREWS(2).
- REMOVE THE FILM FROM THE ADHESIVE BACKING ON THE FOAM STRIP ON THE INSIDE 5. OF THE CLAMP AREA.
- CAREFULLY REPOSITION THE MIRROR BRACKET ONTO THE PONTOON RAILING IN ITS 6. PREDETERMINED POSITION.
 - TIGHTEN THE 1/2" SET SCREWS(2) TO 40 IN-LBS (3.3 FT-LBS) OF TORQUE.
- INSTALL VR-100 MIRROR (4) BY SLIDING THE SCOOP PLATE (7) OVER THE THREADED STUD 8. AND INSERTING THEM THROUGH THE MIRROR BRACKET(1).
- THEN INSTALL THE WASHER(5) AND KNOB(6). 9.



MIRROR BRACKET INSTALLATION

- BEFORE PERMANENTLY INSTALLING THE MIRROR BRACKET(1), PLACE THE ASSEMBLY 1. ONTO THE RAILING OF THE PONTOON IN A DESIRABLE POSITION AS SHOWN.
- BE SURE THAT THE MIRROR BRACKET WILL PIVOT DOWN IN EITHER THE FORWARD OR BACKWARD POSITIONS (DEPENDING ON PONTOON BOAT) WITHOUT CONTACTING THE CONSOL OR THE BIMINI SUPPORT BRACKETS. 2
- ONCE THE DESIRED POSITION IS IDENTIFIED, REMOVE THE MIRROR BRACKET ASSEMBLY 3. FROM THE PONTOON BOAT.
- TO PERMANENTLY LOCK THE MIRROR MOUNT IN PLACE APPLY A SMALL BEAD OF THE 4. THREAD LOCKER(3) TO THE THREADS OF BOTH THE 1/2" SET SCREWS(2).
- REMOVE THE FILM FROM THE ADHESIVE BACKING ON THE FOAM STRIP ON THE INSIDE OF THE CLAMP AREA. 5.
- CAREFULLY REPOSITION THE MIRROR BRACKET ONTO THE PONTOON RAILING IN ITS PREDETERMINED POSITION. 6.
- TIGHTEN THE 1/2" SET SCREWS(2) TO 40 IN-LBS (3.3 FT-LBS) OF TORQUE. 7.
- INSTALL VR-100 MIRROR(4) BY SLIDING THE SCOOP PLATE(7) OVER THE THREADED STUD 8. AND INSERTING THEM THROUGH THE MIRROR BRACKET(1).
 - THEN INSTALL THE WASHER (5) AND KNOB (6).

IMPORTANT - There are certain precautions necessary when cleaning anodized aluminum. DO NOT Use Window Cleaners containing AMMONIA

Aggressive alkaline or acid cleaners must never be used. Cleaning hot, sun-heated surfaces is not recommended as this may accelerate a chemical reaction with the surface. Excessive rubbing should not be necessary.

Mild soaps (defined by ph range of 5.0 - 8.0), i.e., Cascade, Ivory Liquid, Ivory Snow, Joy are recommended for cleaning aluminum surfaces. However, it is important to adequately rinse all surfaces after cleaning. Other cleaning solutions that may be used include...
