PREFACE

1. Read this Quick Start Guide before starting Set-up.

- 2. Then, carefully follow the Instructions, heeding all Warnings.
- 3. Do Not remove the TV back cover or block the TV ventilation openings.
- 4. Do Not use the TV near water or a heat Source.
- 5. Do not pinch or cut the Power Cord.

The product and illustrations in this user's manual is only for explanation purposes and may vary depending on model.

WARNING

Never place a television set in an unstable location. A television set may fall, causing serious personal injury or death. Many injuries, particularly to children, can be avoided by taking simple precautions such as:


- Using cabinets or stands recommended by the manufacturer of the television set.
- Only using furniture that can safety support the television set.
- Ensuring the television set is not overhanging the edge of the supporting furniture.
 Not placing the television set on tall furniture (for example, cupboards or
- bookcases) without anchoring both the furniture and the television set to a suitable support. - Not placing the television set on cloth or other materials that may be located
- between the television set and supporting furniture.
- Educating children about the dangers of climbing on furniture to reach the television set or its controls

If your existing television set is being retained and relocated, the same considerations as above should be applied.

The plug or appliance coupler is used as the disconnect device, the disconnect device shall remain readily operable.

3 Assembly

- Stand Assembly (optional)
- 1. To avoid damage, place the screen on a soft flat surface.
- 2. Attach the stand to the underside of the television set by means of the two screws provided.



Wall Bracket Assembly (optional) 1. Attach the wall bracket to the wall. 2. To avoid damage, place the screen on a soft flat surface.

3. If necessary, remove the stand.

4. Attach the television set to the wall bracket by means of the VESA mounting.

NOTE	 > Make sure that the mounting screws (M4) project into thet elevision set by no more than 8 mm. Longer screws can damage the set. > A wall bracket can be bought separately. Product information available at http://halter.caratec.de > Use only a wall bracket suitable for the size and weight of


1. General Information

To avoid damaging the television set please observe the following safety instructions during setup and use.

ttaching to a wall mount	Please ensure that the screws (M4) project into the television set by no more than 8 mm. The use of longer screws can damage the television set.	
leaning the television set	Before cleaning, disconnect the television set, Use only a soft damp cloth or a special cleaning product for flat-screens.	
ED Display	Too much pressure on the screen can damage the television set.	
eat/damp/humidity	The television set should not be exposed to high temperatures (direct sunlight, radiators, open fire) or to damp. The television set should not be used in areas with high humidity.	
ondensation	If moved from a coal area to one with a higher temperature, the television set should be left for at least an hour before plugging it in A rapid change of temperature can lead to the formation of condensation in the television set itself. This can lead to damage if the television set is in use.	
ir Circulation	To prevent overheating of the television set the ventilation slots at the rear should always be clear.	
mall Objects	It is important to ensure that no small objects or liquids enter the television set. They can cause damage or even fire.	
iquids/Candles	Do not place anything holding a liquid or any candles on the television set.	
rushing	Take care to avoid crushing fingers or other objects when turning the television set in any direction.	
lectric Supply	Use the television set only with the voltage indicated in the specifications. Ensure that there is easy access to the plug and that the television set can always be disconnected from the electricity supply. Do not disconnect the television set by pulling the power cable. Always take hold of the plug. The power cable must not be kinked or placed over sharp edges.	
loving the Tellevision Set	When moving the television set, hold only the casing.	
epairs/Accessories	Repairs and servicing must be undertaken only by authorised and trained personnel.	
ecydling	Electronic devices must be disposed of separately from household waste at authorised disposal sites or handed over to a specialised suppler. Batteries are to be disposed of only in containers provided for this purpose.	


4. Control Buttons

8. Trouble Shooting

Problem	Action
	Make sure that the power cable is properly inserted.
Tellevision set cannot be turned on	Make sure that the $\ensuremath{On}\xspace/\ensuremath{On}\xspace$ is turned on.
	Make sure that the polarity of the power supply is correct.
No Picture	Make sure that the correct source (INPUT) is selected.
No Picture	Make sure that the correct source or antenna is properly connected.
No Sound	Check the volume setting.
No Sound	Check whether the Mute function is activated.
	Make sure that the antenna cable is properly connected.
Poor Picture Quality	Check the picture settings.
Picture too large/small, distorted.	Press the ASPECT button of the remote control to change the image display.
Blue screen	Make sure that the appropriate input (INPUT) is selected.
Television set does not react to the remote control	Make sure that the batteries have been inserted correctly. If necessary, insert new batteries,
DTV/DTB-T mode:	Check the antenna connection.
error message "No signa l "	Re-start the automatic channel search.
Satellite – no signal	Check the list of channels. In the configuration section of the menu you can restore the standard list of channels.
