

Assembly:

Adjustable angle

- On a flat surface assemble mounting pads and rod holder assembly so that pads are flush to mounting service. (Figure 1)
- Position entire assembly against transom ensuring the splines are fully inserted into the rod rack assembly. Mark holes on transom through holes in mounting pads.
- 3. Set assembly aside. Drill ¼" holes through marked holes in transom avoiding fuel lines, electrical harnesses, etc., during the process. (Figure 2) *IMPORTANT-There must be ample space to attach nuts and washers to back of bolts.*
- 4. Use 3M 5200 sealant or equivalent (not included) to coat bolts. Install one pad & spline assembly and fasten with nuts & bolts to transom. (Figure 3) *IMPORTANT-Position rod rack assembly at desired angle over spline when mounting.*
- 5. Insert other spline mount into unattached side of rod rack assembly ensuring pad is flush to the transom. Coat bolts with sealer and fasten securely. (Figure 4)
